Payment of School Fees

Fees are expected to be paid on or before Friday **28th September 2025.** Please remember to forward all proof of payments to the school accounts email

Wrapping of Books

All textbooks and notebooks must be wrapped with transparent wrappers and should be labelled appropriately. Please do not use brown papers. Unwrapped books are not accepted in the classrooms.

School Timings

Please be informed that teaching starts at **8a.m. daily** with Assembly. School will close during the 1st week of resumption as follows:

Penalty of One Thousand Naira only **(N1,000)** will be paid per hour per child for every late pick up.

Sport wears

Sportwear must be worn on the day Physical Education appears on the time-table.

Fruit Day

Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays are fruits days. Pupils must bring fruits with their meals on these days.

Mandate Form

Parents who are yet to submit or complete the mandate form for their ward(s) should kindly do so. Pupils without the form will not be released at the close of school. This system is designed to provide maximum security for our pupils.

Sick Pupils

Parents are advised not to bring sick pupils undergoing medication to the school.

Drop Quizzes

These are impromptu and will be administered in all subjects. They are very short - about 30 minutes each and will test the depth of understanding of concepts by the pupils but also assess the teacher's ability to transfer knowledge seamlessly. The quizzes will add up to the final scores at the end of the term.

School Rules and Regulation

School Clubs

<u>Uniformed Clubs hold on Thursdays</u>: The clubs are Taekwondo, Karate, Red Cross, Cub Scout, Brownie, Man-O-War and Creative Art (You're free to pick just ONE that would interest your child)

Non-Uniformed Clubs: These are optional, they hold on Fridays from 12.30pm – 2.00pm. They are Orchestra, Robotics, Science, Football, Ballet and Swimming.
